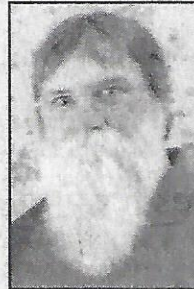
He was preceded in death by his father, Harry McFarren; stepfather, Allen Walker; and two half sisters, Sue Richmond and Sandra Haggerty.
